**Summary: Deuteronomy 30:1-10,19-20**

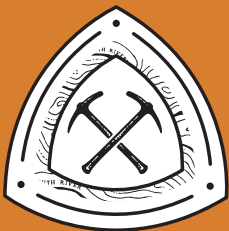
